She is now legally blind and could only enter and leave her house with assistance because of the stairs at both her front and back entrance.

This past summer, ASP volunteers built Donna a deck and wheelchair ramp from her back door over to her parents' home next door. Donna is just one of many hundreds of handicapped and elderly people throughout Appalachia who need help entering and leaving their own home but can't afford it!

Vickie lost her home in an electrical fire. Then she found out her ex-husband had let the insurance lapse and nothing was covered. No bank would let her use the home as collateral so she couldn't get a loan to fix it. And when she finally scraped together her first \$3,000 for repairs, her home was vandalized before she even had a chance to make it secure!

Vickie was devastated.

She had to move into a tiny one-bedroom apartment with her daughter, and constantly wondered whether she'd ever be able to go back to the place that had been her home for 32 years. After being told NO so many times Vickie was depressed and suicidal. "Frankly, the only thing that kept me from following through on suicide," Vickie said, "was the thought of my daughter finding me."

But just like it says in Proverbs 13:12, a sudden good break can make all the difference in the world.

ASP was Vickie's sudden good break. Even though it was more work than we could normally finish over a summer, our Center Director said YES to Vickie and made plans to double crew the site all summer long. Vickie nearly fell over in disbelief — ASP staff and volunteers were the first people even willing to try helping her!

And when the first volunteers showed up to work, Vickie started crying and couldn't stop saying thank you over and over. She kept a scrapbook of pictures from every week all summer long — just so she could remember all they did and pray for each crew!

In the end, Vickie received so much more than new plumbing and electricity, drywall, floors and a roof. She received the most priceless gift of all ... HOPE.

When it came time for her to move back into her fully restored home this summer, all Vickie could say between the tears was — **"Thank you, ASP. Thank you for everything you did here. Thank you for giving my life back to me!"**
