

"I'm not worried anymore." - Joe

When Joe lost both legs to diabetes, life became very difficult for him and his family. Without an accessible bathroom, his wife or kids had to lift him in and out of the tub – and Joe was fearful of being dropped. Then one day his wheelchair fell through the rotting kitchen floor, leaving him fearful of moving around the house. A new floor, an accessible shower, and a ramp out of the house to the driveway have restored Joe's confidence, safety... and freedom!

...DRIER

"We would have had to leave if we couldn't get the floors fixed." - Melinda

Water running down the hill had seeped into Melinda's house, leaving the floors soft and warped. She and her husband worried their two small children would fall right through. ASP angels came to the rescue, digging a drainage ditch to divert the water and re-doing the floors to make them safe. Melinda's daughter, 7-year-old Angel told us, *"I want to be an ASP worker when I grow up!"*
